The buyer shall have free access to the Chometz and / or mixtures containing Chometz that he/she has acquired.

The exact assessment of the quality and value of the goods will take place after Pesach. The buyer's deposit is to be paid to Rabbi Joel Dinin.

"Taking hold of the handkerchief" further legalizes the authorization.

The buyer & seller agree that the original owner may use the chametz after Pesach ends but before the chametz has been purchased back, as long as the seller agrees to pay for the use of any chametz, if the buyer demands payment.
